WHAT IS A STUDENT COMMUNITY DAY ?



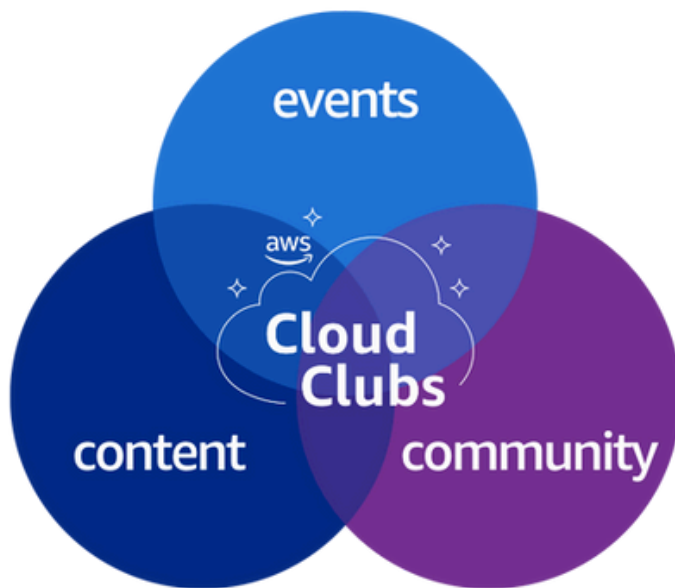

PUNE

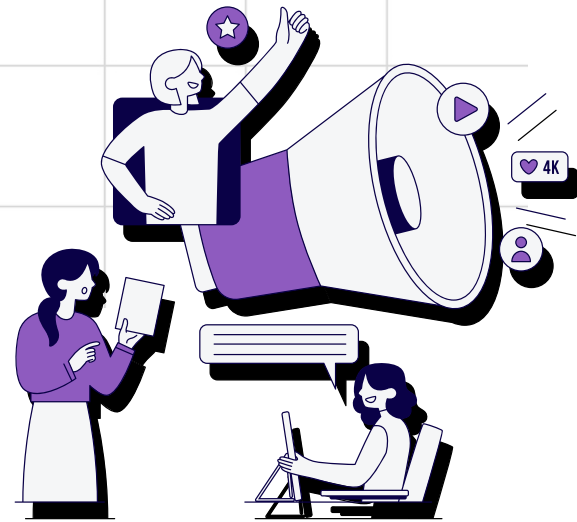
